Access Granted in Part

The Department of Environment is granting access in part to information relating to the request noted below:

There was a petrochemical spill recorded in Jan 2005 at Trails North located at 92166 Alaska Highway. Please provide all documents trailed to the spill.

Timeframe: 20040101 - 20060101

Some of the records you requested contain information that has been withheld from disclosure under the ATIPP Act. We have severed the excepted information so that we could disclose to you the remaining information in the records. The records have been withheld pursuant the following sections under the Access to Information and Protection Privacy Act (ATIPP Act):

• Section 70(1) - disclosure of the information would be an unreasonable invasion of the third party's privacy.
