Final Response to Access Request 23-221

Decision

The Yukon Energy Corporation has completed a thorough search for records responsive to Access Request 23-221. The final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The Yukon Energy Corporation has granted access in part to the 137 pages of responsive records relating to the request noted below:

I want any and all correspondence regarding a new research study into salmon mortality and survival rates at the Yukon Energy dam in Whitehorse. This is a joint project between YEC and the Kwanlin Dun First Nation. As a result, I would like any and all correspondence associated with the study from both the energy corporation, including its management team, and the First Nation. I am wanting to obtain the study itself, if one is available, or preliminary research results. To narrow this request: Please exclude any and all legislation, public engagement materials and materials from the Fish and Wildlife Branch. Timeframe: August 1, 2022 - August 14, 2023.

The Yukon Energy Corporation requested a time extension under section 62(2)(a)(v)(A) and 62(2)(a)(v)(B) on September 25^{th} in order to conduct a Third Party Consult. A 15 day extension was granted on September 27^{th} .

The 'study' as referenced in the request by the applicant made up **79 pages of the responsive records and will be granted in full**. Please note that a <u>final</u> version of the study was shared after August 14, 2023, and was dated September 21st, 2023. This version of the study will be released.

The remaining 58 pages will be granted in part. Redactions have been made as per section 76(1).
