The Department of Energy, Mines and Resources has searched Land Management and has identified no records responsive to Access Request 23-330 noted below:

Any information related to the gravel pit/borrow source that existed on the site of the current gravel pit reservation with land tenure Disposition Number: 105L04-017, PID 100006808, located on Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation Settlement Land parcel LSC R-44B. Timeframe: January 1, 1950 - December 31, 1968

Decision

The Designated Head of the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources has approved the following response to this request:

There are no records found relating to the request. The program area would like to note that due to the Devolution process and the age of the records being requested, we cannot conclusively confirm if any are still in existence. We would advise that it may be worthwhile to consult with Yukon Archives as they are final repository for many of the government's substantive records.
