Dear PSUH colleagues,

As you know, the opioid overdose crisis is a serious public health crisis that continues to affect families and communities across Canada. Tragically, the COVID-19 pandemic has compounded the ongoing overdose crisis, with many jurisdictions having reported record high rates of harms, including deaths, throughout 2020 and into 2021.

In recognition of the communities and families that continue to grapple with the opioid overdose crisis, and increasing substance use amongst

Canadians during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Honourable Patty Hajdu, Minister of Health, announced the launch of the 2021 national call for proposals (CFP) for Health Canada's Substance Use and Addictions Program (SUAP). As part of the Budget 2021 investment of \$116 million, Health Canada, through this call for proposal, is continuing to build up successful community-based programs that can help prevent, treat, and/or reduce the harms associated with opioids, stimulants, alcohol, prescription drugs, other substances that have a high risk of problematic use and addressing unmanaged pain or trauma.

Projects that leverage the expertise of people with lived and living experience with substance use, and/or are able to reach priority populations in Canada, such as young and middle-aged men; Indigenous peoples and communities; people experiencing chronic pain; youth; LGBTQ2 individuals; and rural and remote communities, are particularly encouraged to apply for funding. Interested applicants are encouraged to submit project proposals intended to serve these communities. Applications will be accepted until 2:00pm EST September 24, 2021.

Comme vous le savez, la crise des surdoses d'opioïdes est une grave crise de santé publique qui continue d'affliger des familles et des collectivités partout au Canada. Malheureusement, la pandémie de COVID-19 est venue aggraver cette crise, plusieurs administrations ayant signalé des taux records de méfaits, dont des décès, en 2020 et au début de 2021.

Consciente des collectivités et des familles qui continuent de composer avec la crise de surdose d'opioïdes et de l'augmentation de l'utilisation de substances chez les Canadiens et les Canadiennes depuis la pandémie de COVID-19, l'honorable Patty Hajdu, ministre de la Santé, a annoncé le lancement de l'appel national de propositions dans le cadre du Programme sur l'usage et les dépendances aux substances (PUDS) de Santé Canada pour 2021. Grâce à l'investissement de 116 millions de dollars annoncé dans le budget de 2021, Santé Canada continue de mettre en œuvre, au moyen de cet appel de propositions, des programmes communautaires efficaces axés sur la prévention, le traitement ou la réduction des méfaits associés à la consommation d'opioïdes, de stimulants, d'alcool, de médicaments d'ordonnance, d'autres substances qui présentent un risque élevé de consommation problématique et la douleur non gérée ou les traumatismes.

Les projets qui s'appuient sur l'expertise de personnes ayant une expérience concrète de la consommation de substances ou qui sont en mesure de joindre les populations prioritaires au Canada, dont les hommes jeunes et d'âge moyen, les Autochtones et leurs communautés, les personnes souffrant de douleurs chroniques, les adolescents, les personnes LGBTQ2 et les membres des communautés rurales et éloignées, sont fortement encouragés à faire une demande de financement. Les personnes intéressées à présenter une demande sont invitées à présenter des propositions de projet destiné à servir ces communautés. Les propositions seront acceptées jusqu'à 14h (HAE) le 24 septembre 2021.
