## A traditional camp project at Porter Creek Secondary School is a finalist for an Arctic Inspiration Prize (CBC 5:30 pm)

Porter Creek Secondary School is in the running for an Arctic Inspiration Prize. The school is up for \$100,000. The project, a traditional camp that would build on the school's existing hide camp. Olive Moreland is with the Yukon First Nations Education Directorate and a PCSS grad. She says the impact of the camp would be huge. "The success of having, you know, a fire pit, a space for classes to go that is on campus. I think it's been proven that students can succeed outside. And having the opportunity to have it right there on the campus, you know, just takes away a lot of the stress for teachers trying to get students out on the land." The project is one of three finalists in the Arctic Inspiration Prize's \$100,000 category. The winners will be named in February.

## The Yukon Action Committee on MMIWG2S+ People has released a priorities document based on feedback from families and survivors (CBC 5:30 pm)

The Yukon has released more details on its work to address the crisis of Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls and Two Spirit people that came after a ceremony in Carcross on Tuesday. [Drumming and singing.] The priorities are based on feedback from families and survivors. Jeanie McLean is the Yukon Minister Responsible for the Women and Gender Equity Directorate. She's also a Co-chair of the Yukon Action Committee on MMIWG2S+ People. "The document we are sharing today takes us another step forward on a long, challenging and vitally important journey." The document offers details on ten priorities previously identified by the Action Committee, such as land-based programming and housing. It also adds two new priorities: safe transportation and communication and engaging men and boys to end violence against women. Under each of the priorities are objectives, a list of which groups will lead the implementation of the objectives and timelines ranging from one to 15 years. Ann Maje Raider is another Committee Co-chair. "Together, we can make the needed change happen." The Action Committee will release a full implementation plan for the Yukon's MMIWG2S+ People strategy next spring.

#### Hospice Yukon's Lights of Life events begin today in communities across the territory (CBC 6:30 am)

Christmas can be a tough time of year for people who are grieving. Hospice Yukon is holding its Lights of Life event starting today. It's a chance to pause and remember those who are missed this time of year. People can write a message on a red tag and hang it on a Christmas tree. Deb Higgins is with Hospice Yukon. "Something that we know about grief is it can make us feel very isolated. It can be a very lonely feeling when we're missing someone that we love. And it's really common for people to have a sense that they're all alone in that loneliness. And so one of the things that Lights of Life does by hanging all the red tags on the trees, and people can come and see that and really know that they're not alone." Lights of Life begins at noon with an opening ceremony at the Elijah Smith Building on Main Street in Whitehorse. Trees will be on display until December 22nd. The trees will also be in Dawson City, Watson Lake and many other Yukon communities. There are volunteer tree sitters who are ready to offer compassionate support.

#### FH Collins School was briefly in a lockdown situation Wednesday afternoon (CKRW 7 am)

FH Collins School was briefly in a lockdown situation Wednesday afternoon, according to an email from School Principal Ruth Burridge. All students and staff are safe with no risk of injury or harm. In an email, Burridge stated that around 12:30 pm, an individual trespassed on school property and behaved disruptively in the hallways at which time the school was placed in a hold secured just before 1 pm. At that time, RCMP arrested the individual and escorted the person from the building. No further details were released by authorities or the school.

## Yukon and federal governments have announced their new initiative to protect nature in the Yukon (CKRW 7 am)

The Yukon and federal governments have announced their new initiative to protect nature in the Yukon. Federal Environment Minister Stephen Guilbeault and Yukon Environment Minister Nils Clarke introduced the Canada Yukon Nature Agreement yesterday. They called it the first agreement of its kind to advance nature conservation and protection across the territory. The Government of Canada will invest a total of \$20.6 million to implement the agreements and help protect nature. The goal is to protect or conserve an additional 6 per cent of the Yukon's vast wilderness to reach 25 per cent by 2025.

## Yukon government says 14,450 COVID-19 doses are expected to expire by the end of December (CKRW 7 am)

As news, the federal government is set to see millions of doses of COVID-19 vaccines expire in the near future. The Yukon government is in much of the same boat. According to government spokesperson Samantha Henney, as of yesterday, 14,450 COVID-19 doses are expected to expire by the end of December. Henney said officials have seen a decrease in demand for primary COVID-19 vaccinations and have been placing smaller orders based on the trends. The federal government says the expiring vaccines in its inventory are worth more than \$1,000,000,000.

#### Yukon Party criticises the Liberal government over its spending once again (CKRW 7 am)

The Yukon Party has criticised the Liberal government over its spending once again. In a news release, party officials said government members confirmed last week that the territorial government left \$94 million allocated for capital projects unspent. Official opposition highways and public works critic Stacey Hassard said contractors, First Nations municipalities than Yukoners plan for the season based on expenditures outlined in the capital budget this year. The Yukon government spokesperson responded to this, saying, Despite the impact of labour and the supply chain challenges related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Yukon government spent more than \$343 million on capital projects in 2021/22.

# UPDATE: Environment Minister Nils Clarke says the *Dawson Regional Land Use Plan* plus confirming the protection of areas in the Peel watershed will get the Yukon government close to conservation targets announced at COP-15 (CBC 7:30 am)

The Yukon and federal governments have committed to conserving land in the territory. The targets were announced at a UN biodiversity conference yesterday. The targets match national ones pledged by Ottawa last year. Ministers say they'll work towards protecting 25% of Yukon lands by 2025 and by the end of the decade 30%More than \$20 million will go toward protecting land and biodiversity over three years. Environment Minister Nils Clarke says money like this will accelerate land use planning, something long-

called-for by environmentalists and First Nations. He says getting land plans done is key to reaching targets. "We saw there to be a path forward and in light of that, this was good timing." CPAWS Yukon is applauding the move. A recent survey by the organisation says roughly three quarters of Yukoners agree with the 30% goal. Randi Newton is with CPAWS. "We released a press release on Tuesday calling on Yukon government to step up its conservation commitments and showing that there was strong public support for doing so. And today, by pure happy coincidence of timing, they announced that they are largely stepping up." The agreement also commits to protecting species at risk as well as opportunities for creating Indigenous-protected areas.

## UPDATE: Tourism operators say without White Pass and Yukon Route tourists, it was a challenge to run their business this year (CBC 7:30 am)

A business owner in Carcross says the tourism industry hasn't bounced back to pre-pandemic levels. Jacqueline Saint-Jacques [sp?] runs a jewellery business. She says the cancellation of the White Pass and Yukon Route train to the community was a major blow to business this year. Saint-Jacques: "Some of the government officials might not have been aware of the situation and the impact that that would have had on us. But we, you know, have been operating our businesses for years in this area. We knew right away." Windeyer: Saint-Jacques says her revenues were down 60% from 2019. The White Pass and Yukon Route Railway says pandemic border restrictions played a role in the decision not to run the train last summer. The company says it does plan to bring back train service this season. Yukon's Tourism Minister says the government tried to help loosen some restrictions, but Ranj Pillai police says the restraints still caused lower visitor numbers.

CYFN is celebrating the 50th anniversary of *Together Today for Our Children Tomorrow* (CBC 7:30 am) The Council of Yukon First Nations plans a week of events to mark the 50th anniversary of *Together Today for Our Children Tomorrow*. The policy paper paved the way for First Nation land claims and self-government agreements in the Yukon. It was signed in February 1973. To mark the anniversary, there will be free daily events at the Kwanlin Dün Cultural Centre in Whitehorse from February 11th to 18th. CYFN is also planning workshops with First Nation artists, a speaker series and cultural performances. There will be a community feast in dance, a potluck tonight and a gala performance. Further details on the events will be released in the coming weeks.

**UPDATE:** FH Collins School was briefly in a lockdown situation Wednesday afternoon (CKRW 8 am) Whitehorse FH Collins School was temporarily placed on lockdown Wednesday afternoon. According to an email from the school principal Ruth Burridge, all children and staff are safe and unharmed. Burridge claimed in an email that about 12:30 pm, an individual trespassed on school premises and then behaved disruptively in the halls causing the school to be placed in a hold and secure just before 1 pm. At that time RCMP apprehended the suspect and took the person from the building authorities and the school provided no further information.

## UPDATE: Yukon and federal governments have announced their new initiative to protect nature in the Yukon (CKRW 8 am)

The Canadian and Yukon governments have unveiled a new program to conserve the Yukon's natural resources. Yesterday, Federal Environment Minister Stephen Guilbeault and Yukon Environment Minister Nils Clarke signed the Canada Yukon Nature Agreements. It was dubbed the first pact to enhance wildlife conservation and protection across the territory. The Canadian government will contribute a total of \$20.6 million to the deal and assess safeguarding nature. The objective is to protect or conserve an additional 6 per cent of Yukon's extensive wilderness by 2025, bringing the total to 25 per cent.

A new study has found that a delay in COVID-19 vaccine rollout in Canada have cost the country billions of dollars in economic activity. The C.D. Howe Institute report says that if vaccine delivery had been delayed by six months, Canada would have lost \$156 billion, the roughly 12.5 per cent of its gross domestic product. The analyst who wrote the report says vaccine procurement and administration help prevent COVID-19 cases and hospitalisations to the tune of between 3.7 and \$5.8 billion.
