RE: Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act Final Response for Access Request 22-073

The Department of Energy, Mines and Resources has completed its review of the records responsive to Access Request #22-073 and we are pleased to inform you that access is being granted to the 113 pages of records responsive to this request.

Some of the information has been redacted and withheld from disclosure under:

- paragraph 77(1)(c) of the Act because disclosure may harm the competitive or negotiating position of a third party;
- paragraph 74(1)(a) of the Act, which allows for the discussion of policy issues that may not otherwise occur if the deliberative process were subject to excessive scrutiny;
- subsection 70(1) of the Act because disclosure may be an unreasonable invasion of third party privacy.

There are no fees for this request as the time required to process the records was under five hours.
