Final Response ATIPP Access Request 24-369

Decision

The Department of Environment has searched the Human Resource Branch and has identified information responsive to Access Request 24-369. The final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Full

The Department of Environment has granted access in full to information relating to the request noted below:

Seeking the number violent threat risk assessments (VTRA) conducted, on a month to month basis. Include the total number, the number where the risk was external the public body to staff, and, the number where the risk was internal the public body to staff. Timeframe: January 1, 2022 - September 19, 2024.

Response:

A search for this information has revealed that Department of Environment does not hold complete information relating to this request. The information we do have is being provided in full. While the Department is notified of VTRAs, we do not hold records on VTRAs. Additionally, other Departments may be notified of the same VTRAs since some are shared among Departments. The Public Service Commission should be approached for more complete records.

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The information Environment can provide is that over the time-period requested, Environment has been notified of two VTRAs relating to staff at Environment. The first notification occurred in June 2023. The second notification in February 2024. Both VTRAs were external to staff.

Final Costs

There is no charge to the applicant.

Right to Complain

Pursuant to section 66 of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act you may contact Yukon's Information and Privacy Commissioner with a complaint in respect to this response. Section 66 states:
