The Department of Economic Development has completed its review of ATIPP Request 22-209 after conducting a thorough search of the program areas for records responsive to this request and determined that the applicant's request will be granted in part related to the following request:

We are requesting the most recently updated departmental ministerial issue briefing binders for the 2022 Spring Sitting of the Yukon Legislative Assembly, containing the most recent version of ministerial briefing notes.

Timeframe: April 18, 2022 - April 29, 2022

Clarification: **Yes, we are requesting the briefing binders for the two weeks of April 18 – 29, 2022.**

The response totals 43 pages with 21 pages of records being granted in full and 22 pages being granted in part.

Information pertaining to these pages have been partially severed in accordance with the ATIPP Act under the following sections:

Information in Cabinet records has been withheld under section 67(3)(a) as access must not be granted to Cabinet records as defined in section 67(1)(a), (c) and (f).

Section 68(1)(d) – Confidential information from another government. Records contain information that was accepted in confidence from a municipality.

Section 74(1)(a) – Policy advice and recommendations. Records contain advice or recommendations prepared by or for a public body or a minister.

Section 75(1)(a)(ii)(iv)(b)(i) – Disclosure harmful to economic or financial interests of public body. These records contain information that may prove harmful to contractual or third party economic or financial information of third parties and the government as a whole.

There is no cost to the applicant.
