After consultation with other Canadian jurisdictions and to align with reciprocity agreements in place with Provinces and Territories, we have changed the minimum requirements to become a PMVI Inspector in Yukon.

As part of our review and realignment of our PMVI Inspector program, we require all currently certified PMVI Inspectors to provide the National Safety Code Office with your credentials. If you are a Red Seal, Journeyman or Apprentice please send us a copy of your certification. If you are certified as, 'experienced' please submit a letter stating your years of experience and areas of experience (i.e.: Heavy Trucks, Trailers, Off-road equipment etc.).

You can use any of the following ways to reply to this letter. **If you fail to provide the required information by December 31<sup>st</sup> 2020, your certification will be suspended until the required documents have been received.**

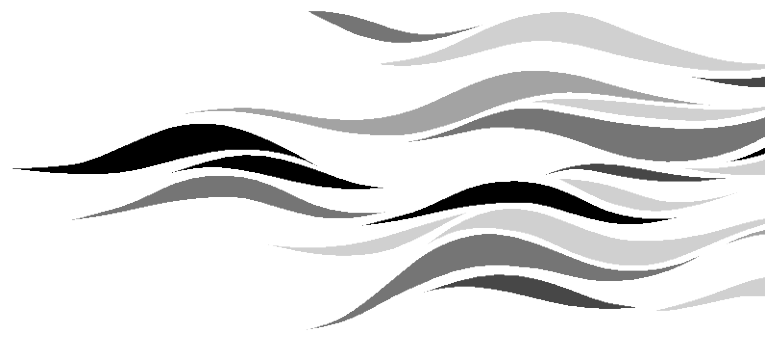

Following a review of certified Yukon PMVI inspectors, inspections and facilities, we have changed the minimum requirements to maintain a PMVI Inspector certification in Yukon.

As part of our review and realignment of our PMVI Inspector program, **as of December 31<sup>st</sup> 2022 we require all certified PMVI Inspectors to have one of the following credentials.**

- Red Seal Mechanic (Heavy Duty or Automotive)
- Red Seal Mechanic (Trailer) \*restricted to trailers only
- Heavy Duty/Automotive Journeyman who has completed 3<sup>rd</sup> year coursework.

You can challenge the Yukon Red Seal certification at Yukon University. You may contact Lenna Charlie at 867-456-3867 or Lenna.Charlie@yukon.ca for details on the process.

As of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, any certified PMVI inspector that has a 'letter of experience' only will be decertified and no longer be able to perform PMVI inspections in Yukon until a Red Seal certificate is presented to the National Safety Code Office.
