RE: Final Response Access Request No. 22-082

Decision

The Department of Environment has searched the Fish and Wildlife Branch for responsive records related to Access Request No. 22-082, response to the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The Department of Environment is granting access in part to information relating to the request noted below:

Following locations: Lower Stewart, White Gold, Sifton/Miners Range, Fish Lake, Wheaton River, Mount Lorne and Teslin River Moose Management Units. Timeframe: April 1, 2021 - February 1, 2022.

NARROWED SCOPE:

I would like to narrow my request to include only in the Fish Lake area.

Some of the records you requested contain information that has been withheld from disclosure under the ATIPP Act. We have severed the excepted information so that we could disclose to you the remaining information in the records. As noted above, the applicant narrowed their request to the Fish Lake Area (Whitehorse South). The more specific locations noted in the raw data have been redacted to protect the animals from potential harm.

The redacted records has been withheld pursuant to the following sections under the Access to Information and Protection Privacy Act (ATIPP Act):

ATIPP Act Sections

- 78. Disclosure harmful to conservation or heritage site
 (b) disclosure may result in damage to, or interference with, the conservation or preservation of a species of plant or animal that is endangered, threatened or vulnerable.
- 72(1)(b)(vi) disclosure may adversely affect the security of property or a system, including a building, vehicle, computer system or communications system.
- 70(1) disclosure of the information would be an unreasonable invasion of the third party's privacy.
