Specifically interested in suspected municipal drinking water PFOA/PFOS levels in Watson Lake.

Question from Dept: I've connected with Environmental Protection and Assessment branch and Water Resources branch in respect of your access request. From what I understand, neither branches has responsive records regarding "...PFAS (and/or PFOA, PFOS) in municipal drinking water supplies."
