Final Response ATIPP Access Request 23-417

The Department of Education has searched Human Resources branch and Policy and Partnerships branch and has identified records responsive to Access Request 23-417 noted below:

[NAME] In 2021/2022, the Department of Education made a decision to employ to conduct an internal investigation into the use of restraints, holds and seclusion of children over several decades at Jack Hulland Elementary School. I am requesting documentation of the decision-making process around choosing this type of internal investigation. Specifically, I am requesting all communications and notes by, from [NAME] and to the Director of Human Resources. including emails, notebooks, digital records of voicemails, meeting notes, Teams posts, reports and recommendations [NAME] using search strings such as but not limited to: "Jack Hulland", "Jack Hulland Elementary", "investigation", "internal investigation", "HR Investigation", "human resources investigation", "call to the bar", "Yukon call to the bar", "mitha", "mitha law group".

Timeframe: November 10, 2021 - April 30, 2022.
