Decision

The department of Tourism and Culture has searched the Corporate Services branch and has identified records responsive to Access Request #22-010. Our final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The department of Tourism and Culture has provided access in part to information and records relating to the request noted below:

The request is for the most recent, final versions at the end of the legislative session of individual ministerial briefing binders or briefing notes prepared for government ministers during the 2021 Fall Legislative Sitting. Timeframe: October 28, 2021 – December 3, 2021

Cabinet information consisting of advice, recommendations and briefing material prepared for a Minister or Cabinet was redacted using section 67(3)(a) of the ATIPP Act.

Information reflecting advice and recommendations prepared for the public body or minister have been withheld under section 74(1)(a) of the ATIPP Act.

Information was withheld under section 75(1)(a)(b)(i)(ii) of the ATIPP Act as it would reveal financial information of the Government of Yukon or a public body and that has, or is reasonably likely to have, monetary value or prejudice the financial or economic interests of the public body.

Third party business information was redacted under section 77(1)(a)(b)(c) of the ATIPP Act. Release of this information could reasonable be expected to result in undue financial loss or gain, result in similar information no longer being supplied or harm the competitive or negotiating position of the third party.
