RE: Access to Information and Protection of Privacy (ATIPP) Act Access Request #21-286

The Department of Environment has completed its review of the records responsive to Access Request #21-286 and we are pleased to inform you that access is being provided to the enclosed 36 pages of records.

Some of the records you requested contain information that has been withheld from disclosure under the ATIPP Act. We have severed the excepted information so that we could disclose to you the remaining information in the records.

The severed information has been withheld from disclosure under sections 67 (Cabinet confidence), 70 (third party personal information), 74 (policy and advice), and 72 (information related to law enforcement).

In addition 19 pages of records have been withheld completely under section 76 (disclosure harmful to intergovernmental relations) of the ATIPP Act.

Details about each severance are provided in the enclosed summary of comments. The detailed sections supporting the excising of particular information are available at online at https://legislation.yukon.ca/acts/atipp_c.pdf.
