

COVID-19 case counts, Yukon, June 1, 2021 – October 19, 2021

Vaccination Status ^[1]	Cases
Fully Vaccinated	157
Partially Vaccinated	59
Unvaccinated	564

¹ Fully vaccinated, last dose of series at least 2 weeks prior to symptom onset or identification as a case; Partially vaccinated, incomplete series with most recent dose at least 14 days prior to symptom onset or identification as a case. Unvaccinated – no vaccine received or received one dose of an approved vaccine but less than 14 days prior to symptom onset or identification as a case

Note:

- The majority of cases are among unvaccinated individuals.
- There are **many more** vaccinated individuals than partially and unvaccinated individuals in the Yukon.
- Thus, the best comparison would be to look at rates based on the population of fully vaccinated, partially vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals

^[1] FV – fully vaccinated, last dose of series at least 2 weeks prior to symptom onset or identification as a case; PV – partially vaccinated, incomplete series with most recent dose at least 14 days prior to symptom onset or identification as a case.
