Wildfire fire crews ramp up response to Bear Creek fire, confirm its spread away from Haines Junction

The Bear Creek fire has continued to grow northwards and away from Haines Junction with help from winds from the south. As of this afternoon, it is about 35-40 hectares large.

Unfortunately, smoke from the fire remains visible from elevated vantage points. Wildland Fire Management confirms that no people or property are at imminent risk, although we have deployed a sprinkler kit on one structure as a precautionary measure.

Our crews are working hard to contain and put this fire out, however it is not yet under control. Wildland Fire Management has deployed 15 firefighters, heavy equipment, 3 helicopters, and both of Yukon's air tanker groups to work on this fire.
