### BY-ELECTION SUMMARY

A writ of election was issued by the Commissioner of the Yukon on January 2, 1987 to fill the vacancy in Tatchun caused by the resignation of Mr. Roger Coles.

Nomination Day was Monday, January 12, 1987. Four candidates were nominated to contest the election and no candidate withdrew his nomination.

Revision Hearings were held on January 20 and 21 at which time 28 names of qualified electors were added to the preliminary list of electors. One name was removed from the list resulting in a total of 408 names on the official list of electors.

An Advance Poll was held on Sunday, January 25 and Monday, January 26 and 31 voters cast ballots in Carmacks and Pelly Crossing. Polling Day was February 2, 1987 and during the hours the polls were open 312 electors voted. An additional 19 electors in polling division 3 voted by mail-in ballots. Totally 362 electors voted out of the 408 who were entitled.

The return to the writ of election for the Electoral District of Tatchun was made on February 16, 1987.
