New deputy minister for Finance announced

WHITEHORSE— Premier Darrell Pasloski is pleased to announce the appointment of Katherine White as deputy minister for the Department of Finance.

"Ms. White brings a wealth of advanced strategic leadership skills in the public sector to her new position with the Yukon government," Pasloski said. "Her robust strategic and analytical skills have earned her a stellar reputation amongst senior levels of government as well as the respect and trust of her colleagues and clients."

Prior to this appointment White served as the assistant deputy minister, chief economist and executive director of the Alberta Treasury Board and Finance.
