WHITEHORSE—The 42nd annual Geoscience Forum and Trade Show will be hosted in Whitehorse by the Yukon Chamber of Mines, November 15 to 19.

Yukon-based mining and exploration companies, researchers and businesses will also be present. Discussion topics will include initiatives, progressive partnerships and new developments to move Yukon's mining industry forward.
