





Wildfire smoke from High Level, Alberta arrives in Yukon

Large portions of Yukon are experiencing smoke haze that has been blown from the wildfire near High Level, Alberta by winds from the southeast. Wildland Fire Management confirms that this smoke is not from wildfires in or near Yukon.

Yukoners can expect that the smoke will continue to affect all parts of the territory over the next 48 hours or longer. Yukon Protective Services will continue to provide updates via Facebook and Twitter.
