

June 29, 2025, Mayo region wildfire update

Mayo region wildfire update (Sunday June 29):

- MA-006 (North Ferry Hill) This fire is burning north of Stewart Crossing and the Silver Trail Highway. Structure protection is in place in the area. An evacuation alert remains in place for properties along the Silver Trail Highway, extended from km markers 4 to 24.
- MA-019 (Francis Plateau/Ethel Lake) Skimmer aircraft were very effective on this fire yesterday, and it received a bit of rain. Today crews are working along the SW and Western edges, to prevent spread towards the NND Culture Camp. The fire is being bucketed with 3 helicopters today. Structure protection is in place on values in the area. The area around the lake remains under evacuation alert.
- MA-022 (Ladue Lake): This fire is about 7 kilometres from Keno City. There is swampy terrain between the fire and the community. Keno is not currently at risk. The fire is being monitored.
- MA-025 (Janet Creek): This fire is 13 km NE of Mayo and is displaying low fire activity. There is no direct threat to Mayo at this time. This fire received significant rain this morning. Up to 2 crews and one helicopter are working the fire today in an effort to get it under control.
