

Lacelle Lake fire (HJ-007) closes Aishihik Lake Road

June 22, 2025



The Lacelle Lake fire (HJ-007) is an estimated 500-hectare fire located mid-way up the Aishihik Lake Road. The fire was initially reported at 9:30 pm on June 21. Due to proximity to the fire, the road was closed earlier today. Tomorrow morning, crews from Haines Junction fire centre will assess the fire with the goal of keeping the road accessible for people departing the lake.

The fire is approximately 30 kilometres north of the Aishihik Lake Campground and a long way from Aishihik Village. The road remains closed and non-essential travel north on the road is not recommended.

Wildland Fire Management is working with Champagne and Aishihik First Nations to make sure people nearby remain safe and informed.
