

Mayo region wildfire update – last updated June 30, 2025

Tuesday, June 30, 2025, 4:30 pm

Evacuation Alerts:

- [East of the Silver Trail](#) between kilometres 4 and 24. This alert has been rescinded.
- [Ethel Lake area](#), this alert is in response to the danger from the Francis Plateau fire (MA-019).

Wildfire Activity and Response

Cool and wet conditions over the past two days have allowed crews to make good progress on resourced fires. MA-024 and MA-025 are now being held and the evacuation alert along Silver Trail highway has been rescinded.

Cooler conditions and scattered showers have reduced fire behaviour across the region though the amounts of rain received has varied considerably. Cloudy and cool conditions are expected to continue through tomorrow with a risk of thunderstorms this evening. A warming and drying trend is forecast to begin mid-week.

North Ferry Hill (MA-006)

- This fire is burning north of Stewart Crossing and the Silver Trail Highway. Structural protection is in place in the area. Size is estimated at 11,500 hectares and the fire is Out of Control. Today crews are working on containing the fire, extinguishing hotspots, and maintaining structural protection.

Francis Plateau fire (MA-019)

- Today crews are working along the South, Southwest and Western edges, to extinguish hotspots. Size is estimated at 750 hectares, and the fire is Out of Control. Three helicopters are providing bucketing support. Structural protection is in place on values in the area including the Na-Cho Nyäk Dun culture camp and cabins. Heavy equipment is building a dozer guard along the Ethel Lake Road. The area around the lake remains under evacuation alert.

Ladue Lake fire (MA-022)

- This fire is about 7 kilometres from Keno City and estimated at 3,500 hectares in size. There is swampy terrain between the fire and the community. Keno is not currently at risk.

Two Sisters Hill fire (MA-024)

- This fire is confirmed at 5.25 hectares. Crews took advantage of favourable conditions yesterday and the fire is now being held. One crew and a helicopter will continue to extinguish hotspots today.

Janet Creek fire (MA-025)

- This fire is now Being Held and is 16 hectares. It is 13 kilometres Northeast of Mayo and is showing low fire activity. There is no direct threat to Mayo at this time. Two crews and two helicopters will continue to extinguish hotspots today.
