

Update on Mayo-area fires causing evacuation alerts

Update on Mayo-area fires causing evacuation alerts.

The North Ferry Hill fire (BC-006) is an out of control wildfire in the Northern Tutchone fire district. It is burning north of Stewart Crossing and the Silver Trail.

This fire is currently receiving a modified response, meaning that firefighting crews have set up protection on structures close to the fire as a precaution. On June 23 the fire received 15 millimetres of rain on the west side and is showing reduced fire behaviour. A wildland fire crew and a water tender were assigned to the fire to maintain structure protection, protect energy lines and keep the highway open.

An evacuation alert remains in place for the area East of the Silver Trail between kilometres 8 and 24, including all properties along the Silver Trail Highway

The Francis Plateau fire (MA-019) is an out-of-control wildfire located in the Northern Tutchone fire district. It is burning northeast of Ethel Lake Road.

On June 22, the fire showed extreme behaviour, moving downhill towards the lake. While the fire did not impact the Na-Cho Nyäk Dun outpost or other structures, Wildland Fire did contact nearby residents to inform them of the fire. Current conditions are less severe, but the fire remains active.

No new growth has been seen towards the NND outpost. A two-person Special Heavy Operations Team (SHOT) team has installed structure protection, such as sprinklers, on vulnerable values. Two wildland fire crews, an incident commander and two dozers are also working in the area to widen the road as a fire defense and assess suppression options on the south flank.
