

Yukon River fire (CA-006) visible to paddlers west of the Thirty Mile

June 21, 2025



A wildfire is burning on both sides of the Yukon River approximately 5.5 kilometres west from the Thirty Mile.

The Yukon River Fire (CA-006) is 10 hectares and was first reported on June 20 around 8:30 pm. It is currently burning on both sides of the river and is out of control. Paddlers in the area will see smoke and possibly flames if travelling on the Yukon River.

If you are planning a paddling trip in the area, please be prepared for conditions, including low visibility from smoke. You should leave behind a trip plan, carry a device for remote communication and follow other AdventureSmart suggestions.
