Public viewing locations announced for the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge's Yukon visit

WHITEHORSE—Yukoners are encouraged to join in celebrating the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge's first official visit to Yukon by attending community events in Whitehorse or in Carcross.

Maps outlining areas designated for the public will be available at www.gov.yk.ca/royalvisit2016.

People attending the downtown Whitehorse community festival are asked to arrive no later than 8:30 a.m. on September 28, and are encouraged to carpool or take public transit to avoid parking congestion downtown.

People attending Carcross community celebrations are encouraged to arrive no later than 10:30 a.m. on September 28. Public parking is available near Montana Services gas station and RV parking. Shuttles will be available from the public parking areas to the designated public viewing area, near the Carcross Commons.

Yukoners are encouraged to go to events in either Whitehorse or Carcross, but not both, based on the timing of the events and expected traffic congestion moving between the two locations.
