Roof replacement for Destruction Bay Community Centre

The Destruction Bay Community Centre has a new roof thanks to nearly \$26,000 from the Government of Yukon.

Funding was provided through the Small Capital Projects Program in the amount of \$20,000 and \$5,988 from the Community Development Fund.

The Kluane Lake Athletic Association oversaw the Destruction Bay Community Centre roof replacement. The centre currently houses a gymnasium, offices and the post office in the community of Destruction Bay and is an important gathering place for members of the small community. The project created employment for two people in the community.

Quick facts

- Funding for the Small Capital Project Program is allocated by the Department of Community Services. Funding for the Community Development Fund is allocated by the Department of Economic Development.
- The Small Capital Projects Program supports community recreation infrastructure needs that increase access and participation to sport and recreation, ensuring health and safety are top priority.
 - Funding is available to Local Authorities for Recreation in unincorporated Yukon communities.
 - Applicants can receive up to \$20,000 for capital recreation projects that address health and safety, structural integrity, protection of property and end of lifespan concerns.
- The Community Development Fund's primary goal is to support projects that provide long-term benefits and value to Yukon communities. The projects are awarded based on merit and the ability to demonstrate social, cultural and economic benefits.
- The Community Development Fund is divided into three tiers with five intake deadlines:
 - $\circ~$ Tier I: Applications of \$20,000 or less (intake deadlines in January, May, July and October).
 - Tier 2: Applications of \$20,001 to \$75,000 (intake deadline in May and September).
 - Tier 3: Applications of \$75,001 or more (intake deadline in January)
