Government of Yukon provides funding to the Golden Age Society

The Government of Yukon's Community Development Fund awarded \$18,900 to the Golden Age Society through Tier 1 funding last week. The society will apply this funding to a feasibility study for the assessment and expansion of the group's facilities in Whitehorse.

The Golden Age Society has operated since 1976, providing a drop-in centre for local and visiting seniors.

The feasibility study will be used to conduct an assessment of the society's administrative headquarters for expansion and increased accessibility options, as well as bringing the facility up to current building codes. The project will create 300 hours of employment for four people.

Quick facts

- The Community Development Fund's primary goal is to support projects that provide long-term benefits and value to Yukon communities. Projects are awarded based on merit and the ability to demonstrate social, cultural and economic benefits.
- The Community Development Fund is divided into three tiers with five intake deadlines:
 - Tier I: Applications of \$20,000 or less (intake deadlines in January, May, July and October).
 - Tier 2: Applications of \$20,001 to \$75,000 (intake deadline in May and September).
 - Tier 3: Applications of \$75,001 or more (intake deadline in January).
