Premier sets direction for ministers

Premier Sandy Silver has released mandate letters to ministers that set out the vision for the Government of Yukon's future. The letters highlight specific tasks ministers and their departments have been asked to undertake by the premier to accomplish the Government of Yukon's mandate.

Mandate letters are sent to incoming ministers, or following a change in responsibilities. They typically outline the overall approach and style of a new government and highlight initial priorities.
