The Government of Yukon has set the agenda for the fall sitting, which will begin on October 3 at 1 p.m.

During this sitting, the government will table legislation including the *Act to Amend the Workers' Compensation Act and the Occupational Health and Safety Act (2017)*, and the *Legal Profession Act, 2017*.

The public is invited to attend the opening of the fall sitting at 2071 Second Avenue in Whitehorse.
