Year to Date 345,200


An estimated 345,200 people visited Yukon from January to August 2014. This represents a decrease of 15,200 people or -4% compared to the same period last year.

The Yukon Visitor Tracking Program (YVTP) is a volumetric model that estimates the number of people that visit Yukon on a monthly basis. The model includes visitors entering Yukon via highway, train, and air; the model does not include Yukon residents.


Total—August

A total of 79,593 people entered Yukon through Canada Border Services Agency's border crossings in August. This represents a decrease of 1,541 people or –2% compared to August, 2013. An increase was experienced in air (up 2,865 or +232%). Decreases were experienced in private vehicle (down 3,661 people or –8%), in motorcoach (down 745 people or –2%). By origin, an increase was experienced by Others (up 1,643 people or +17%). Decreases were experienced for US (down 2,472 people or –5%) and Canada (down 712 people or –4%).

Year to Date

Year to date (January to August), a total of 278,926 people entered Yukon through Canada Border Services Agency's border crossings. This represents a decrease of 15,054 people or –5% compared to January to August, 2013.



Private Vehicle

Decreases were experienced in private vehicle (down 3,661 people or –8%) compared to August 2013. By origin, an increase was experienced by Others (up 463 people or +13%). Decreases were experienced by US (down 2,904 people or –11%) and Canada (down 1,220 people or –9%). *Private Vehicle: automobile, cycle, and pedestrian.*

Motorcoach

Decreases were experienced in motorcoach (down 745 people or –2%) compared to August 2013. By origin, an increase was experienced by Canada (up 55 people or +1%) and Others (up 833 people or +16%). A decrease was experienced by US (down 1,633 people or –6%).

International Air

Increases were experienced in air (up 2,865 people or +232%) compared to August 2013. By origin, increases were experienced by US (up 2,065 people or +2488%), Canada (up 453 people or +242%) and Others (up 347 people or +36%).

A total of 38,116 sameday visitors entered Yukon through Canada Border Services Agency's border crossings in August. Increases were experienced in motorcoach (up 2,249 people or +8%) and in air (up 4 people). A decrease was experienced in private vehicle (down 2,433 people or – 21%). By origin, an increase was experienced by Others (up 914 people or +19%). A decrease was experienced by US (down 1,094 people or -3%).

Multiple Night Visit

A total of 24,810 multiple night visitors entered Yukon through Canada Border Services Agency's border crossings in August. An increase was experienced in air (up 2,408 people or +230%). Decreases were experienced in Private Vehicle (down 8 people) and motorcoach (down 3,049 people or –61%). By origin, an increase was experienced by Others (up 729 people or +14%). A decrease was experienced by US (down 1,378 people or –7%).

Port of Entry—August

Increases were experienced at Pleasant (up 1,042 people or +22%), Dawson City airport (up 2,608 people or 2998%), and Whitehorse airport (up 270 people or +24%). Decreases were experienced at Beaver Creek (down 975 people or -7%), Fraser (down 2,717 people or -5%), Little Gold (down 1,755 people or -31%) and Old Crow (down 14 people).

Port of Entry—Year to Date

Year to date (January to August) increases were experienced at Pleasant (up 2,180 people or +10%), Dawson City airport (up 8,444 people or 2035%) and Whitehorse airport (up 964 people or +27%). Decreases were experienced at Beaver Creek (down 2,505 people or -5%), Fraser (down 19,161 people or -10%), Little Gold (down 4,962 or -30%) and Old Crow (down 14 people).
