87,500


An estimated 87,500 people visited Yukon from January to May 2014. This represents a decrease of 3,800 people or -4% compared to the same period last year.

The Yukon Visitor Tracking Program (YVTP) is a volumetric model that estimates the number of people that visit Yukon on a monthly basis. The model includes visitors entering Yukon via highway, train, and air; the model does not include Yukon residents.

Total—May

A total of 35,486 people entered Yukon through Canada Border Services Agency's border crossings in May. This represents a decrease of 745 people or –2% compared to May, 2013. An increase was experienced in air (up 1,295 or +10792%). Decreases were experienced in private vehicle (down 166 people or -1%) and in motorcoach (down 1,874 people or -10%). By origin, increases were experienced for Canada (up 313 people or +4%). Decreases were experienced for US (down 939 people or –4%) and Others (down 119 people or -2%).

Private Vehicle

Decreases were experienced in private vehicle (down 460 people or –4%) compared to May 2013. By origin, an increase was experienced by Canada (up 355 people or +5%). Decreases were experienced by US (down 460 people or –4%) and Others (down 61 people or –8%). *Private Vehicle: automobile, cycle, and pedestrian.*

Motorcoach

Decreases were experienced in motorcoach (down 1,874 people or -10%) compared to May 2013. By origin, decreases were experienced by US (down 1,454 people or -12%), Canada (down 241 people or -12%), and Others (down 179 people or -4%).

International Air

Increases were experienced in air (up 1,295 people or +10792%) compared to May 2013. By origin, increases were experienced by US (up 975 people or +13929%), Canada (up 199 people or +9950%), and Others (up 121 people or +4033%).

Sameday Visit

A total of 20,222 sameday visitors entered Yukon through Canada Border Services Agency's border crossings in May. Increases were experienced in air (up 184 people). Decreases were experienced in private vehicle (down 112 people or –2%) and motorcoach (down 884 people or -6%). By origin, increases were experienced by Others (up 11 people). Decreases were experienced by US (down 823 people or -5%).

Multiple Night Visit

A total of 6,497 multiple night visitors entered Yukon through Canada Border Services Agency's border crossings in May. An increase was experienced in air (up 912 people or +9120%). Decreases were experienced in private vehicle (down 409 people or -7%) and motorcoach (down 749 people or -90%). By origin, decreases were experienced by US (down 116 people or -2%) and Others (down 130 people or -16%).

Port of Entry—May

Increases were experienced at Little Gold (up 208 people or +96%), Pleasant (up 423 people or +17%), Dawson City port (up 1098 people or 54900%), and Whitehorse airport (up 197 people or +1970%). Decreases were experienced at Beaver Creek (down 982 people or -17%) and Fraser (down 1689 people or -6%).

Port of Entry—Year to Date

Year to date (January to May) increases were experienced at Little Gold (up 208 people or +96%), Pleasant (up 429 people or +7%), Dawson City port (up 981 people or 323%), and Whitehorse airport (up 789 people or +6575%). Decreases were experienced at Beaver Creek (down 1760 people or -14%) and Fraser (down 1760 people or -14%).
