Election Summary

Writs of election for the general election on February 20, 1989, were issued to the returning officers of the 16 electoral districts by Commissioner Ken McKinnon on January 20, 1989.

At the close of nominations on Monday, January 30, 1989, 47 candidates had been nominated to contest the elections. The number of candidates endorsed by each registered political party was as follows:

P.C. Yukon Party 16 Yukon Liberal Party 15 Yukon New Democratic Party 16.

Three candidates were nominated in each electoral district except in the Electoral District of Klondike. There were no independent candidates nominated.

Advance polls were held throughout the Yukon on Sunday, February 12 and Monday, February 13, 1989, at which 706 voters cast their ballots.

Of the record 15,093 electors who were eligible, a total of 11,768 people voted. In this number were 75 electors who voted by mail-in ballot papers. Those voters entitled to use mail-in ballots included the residents of polling divisions in which there were not more than 25 qualified electors. This number also included people who were patients in a hospital or remand prisoners in a correctional centre after the close of revision hearings on February 8, 1989.

It had been anticipated that an unusually high number of electors would be outside the Yukon and would therefore be entitled to vote by proxy. An estimated 1,500 proxy applications were distributed and 453 voters took advantage of this method of voting.

A judicial recount was conducted on February 25, 1989, for the Electoral District of Watson Lake. The results of the official addition on February 23, 1989, confirmed that there was a difference of four votes between the candidate with the greatest number of votes and another candidate. At the recount one ballot which had been rejected was allowed. This did not change the outcome of the election.

The result of the election in the Electoral District of Watson Lake was declared on February 25, 1989. In the remaining 15 electoral districts the election results were declared on March 6, 1989.
