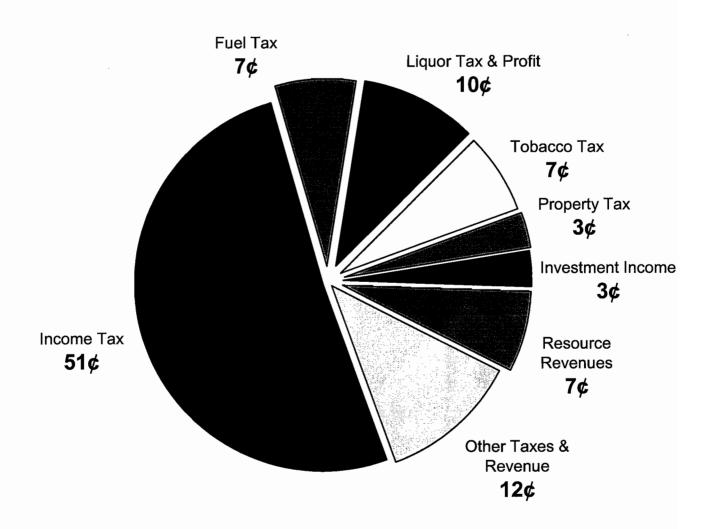

- A) Rate changes may have occurred since the time of the survey (March 14, 2006). To determine current rates or upcoming rate changes, reference should be made to each jurisdiction's Department of Finance.
- B) The following jurisdictions levy a surcharge on personal income tax:

Newfoundland, 9% of provincial tax in excess of \$7,032

Prince Edward Island, 10% of provincial tax in excess of \$5,200

Nova Scotia, 10% of provincial tax in excess of \$10,000

Ontario, 20% of provincial tax in excess of \$4,106 and 36% of provincial tax in excess of \$5,065

Yukon, 5% of territorial tax in excess of \$6,000.

- C) Provincial share of Harmonized Sales Tax.
- D) PEI tax rate for both gas and diesel includes 10% tax on the estimated wholesale price. The flat rate component is 11.5 ¢/litre, plus 10% ad valorem component. The tax rate changes on the first day of each month.
- E) Income tax brackets are indexed using the Consumer Price Index.
- F) New Brunswick's small business rate will be reduced to 1.5% effective July 1, 2006.
- G) Income tax brackets are indexed using the provincial rate of inflation.
- H) The rate is 16.25% on non-active business income.
- I) Northwest Territories general corporate income tax rate will be reduced to 11.5% effective July 1, 2006.
- J) Northwest Territories and Nunavut have two tax rates for gasoline for highway usage (10.7) and for off-highway usage (6.4). The 6.4 rate applies for communities not served by the highway system.

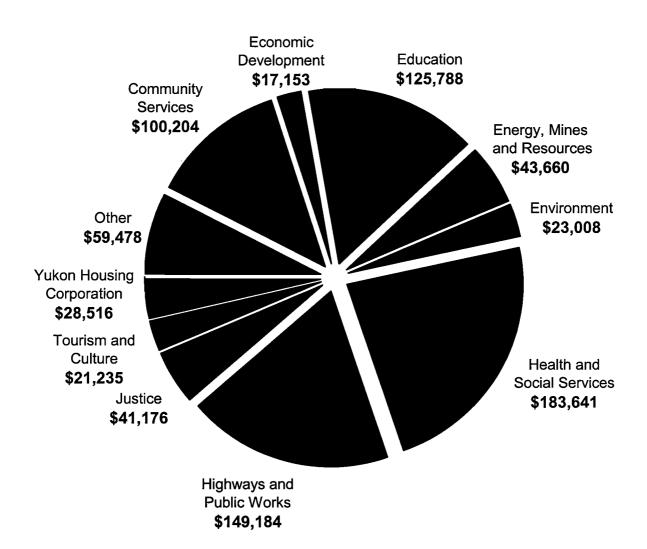

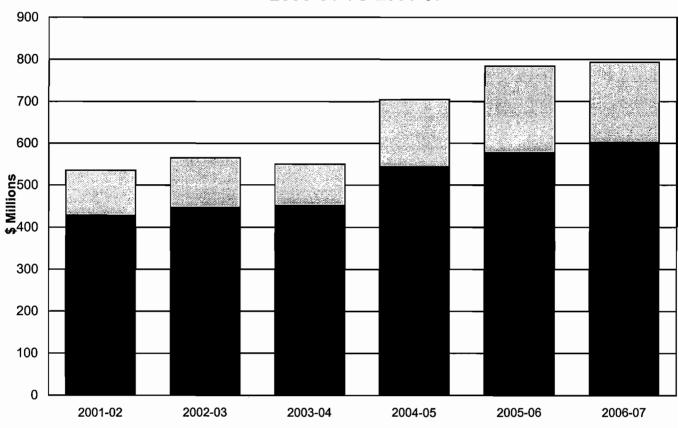
