



2025 ONLINE FRONTCOUNTRY RESERVATION SERVICE

Post-camping survey results

Overview

- Online reservations were offered at: Wolf Creek, Pine Lake, Marsh Lake and Tombstone Mountain frontcountry campgrounds.
- New users of the reservation service were invited to complete a survey after their stay.
- The results show overall satisfaction with the service and help Yukon government understand how the system is supporting campers across the territory.

Reservation activity

- 6,579 reservations made
- 411 post-camping respondents
- 57% average seasonal occupancy
- 85% occupancy in July–August
- 98% August occupancy – Tombstone Mountain

Campsite violations

75% reduction in unattended campsite violations between 2022 and 2025



Operational efficiencies

103 reservable campsites represent 9% of total front-country inventory



Administrative time saved



2025 post-camping survey results for frontcountry reservation users show that overall satisfaction remains high.
