Key Indicator report

The time frame used for reporting is the 2023 to 2024 fiscal year. Quarter 1 represents April to June 2023, Quarter 2 represents July to September Quarter 3 represents October to November 2023, and Quarter 4 represents December 2023 to March 2024.

Rural Community Home Care Enhancements

For the 2023 to 2024 fiscal year Home Care provided home support services in 93% of the rural Yukon communities.

Home First and Client Supports Programs

For the 2023 to 2024 fiscal year Home Care supported 11 complex care clients to live at home.
