Key Indicator report

The time frame used for reporting is the 2024 to 2025 fiscal year. Quarter 1 represents April to June 2024, Quarter 2 represents July to September, Quarter 3 represents October to November, and Quarter 4 represents December 2024 to March 2025.

Rural Community Home Care Enhancements

For the 2024 to 2025 fiscal year Home Care provided home support services in 100% of the rural Yukon communities.

Home First and Client Supports Programs

For the 2024 to 2025 fiscal year Home Care supported 23 complex care clients to live at home.
