

# ACCESS TO INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT

# **Assisting Applicants**

Employees in the ATIPP Office can assist you with your access request by helping you find the correct public body to send your request to and clarifying your request if required.

The ATIPP Office provides information that that may help you to gain a greater understanding of how public bodies are structured and what programs, activities and services they provide.

#### Reasonable efforts

Employees in the ATIPP Office cannot write or submit your access (ATIPP) request for you. The ATIPP Office can work with you and the responsive public body to help you clarify or narrow your request to ensure that your request will result in the most useful information you are requesting.

This includes guiding you to the divisions, units, branches and/or positions that are likely to hold the records related to your request.
