Premier appoints Yukon Development Corporation president

WHITEHORSE—Premier Darrell Pasloski announced today the appointment of Justin Ferbey as president of the Yukon Development Corporation (YDC).

He has received numerous leadership and innovation awards, and has spent considerable time volunteering for local, national and international associations and boards.

Ferbey holds a bachelor of arts and science, a master of business and has obtained certifications in conflict resolution, commerce and management.

"I look forward to working with Mr. Ferbey in continuing to move forward on many important YDC initiatives," Yukon Development Corporation chair Joanne Fairlie said. "Mr. Ferbey will bring valuable business planning, development and investment experience to the corporation."

Ferbey will assume his new role in October, replacing acting YDC president George Ross.
