Legislative assembly to reconvene Tuesday March 25

WHITEHORSE—Premier Darrell Pasloski announced today that the Speaker will reconvene the first session of the 33rd Yukon Legislative Assembly on Tuesday, March 25 at 1 p.m.

"Our government is approximately half-way through our mandate and we are proud of what we have been able to accomplish in the past two-and-a-half years," Pasloski said. "Our focus during this sitting will be to continue to deliver on our commitments and to achieve benefits for Yukoners, while spending responsibly."

A key aspect of this sitting will be the 2014/15 budget, as well as a number of other legislative proposals.

"Our history of excellent fiscal management puts us in a strong position to make new investments in infrastructure for the territory and help create more jobs for Yukoners," Pasloski added.
