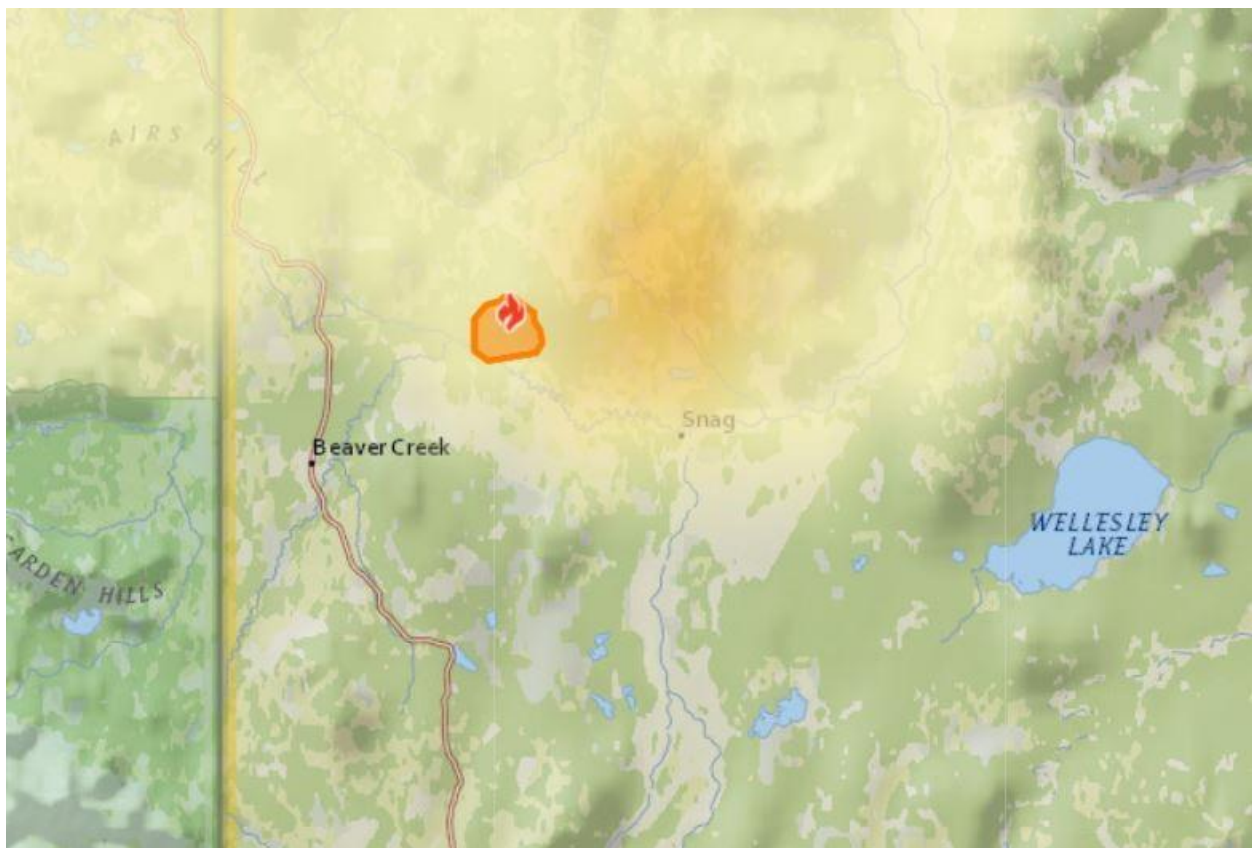


# Fire burning 15 kilometres northeast of Beaver Creek

July 3, 2022

The Snag Creek fire (BC-003) is burning around 15 kilometres northeast of Beaver Creek in the strategic zone. The fire originated from a suspected lightning strike July 1. The Snag Creek fire is currently 900 hectares in size but burning away from the community. It does not present an immediate risk to people and property. Wildland Fire is in communication with the owners of a nearby structure.
