Chairman's Message

The Yukon General Election was held June 7, 1982. Since the last general election held in 1978 there have been major changes in the elections legislation--most importantly an elector became able to be sworn-in at the polls on polling day and, as well, the system for proxy voting changed to allow the elector a simpler method of voting by proxy--no certificates were required.

The Elections Board retained two of its original members--Chairman, Paul Birckel of Whitehorse was re-appointed in May, 1982, and Mary McCulloch of Watson Lake. Currently, a vacancy for the third Board member exists. The Board hired Jo-Ann Waugh as Administrator of Elections and ten Returning Officers were appointed to vacancies.

As in 1978, sixteen members were elected to the Yukon Legislative Assembly and the emergence of party politics on a formal basis is now significantly entrenched.

The Elections Board would like to thank the Returning Officers and all other elections officers for their efficient administration of the 1982 General Election.
