The Department of Economic Development has completed its review of ATIPP Request 21-253 after conducting a thorough search of the program areas for records responsive to this request (totaling four pages) and determined that the applicant's request will be granted in full to the following request:

Funding given to Yukon University's Innovation & Entrepreneurship unit. The exact amount of funding for each time funding was given and a precise description of what exactly each funding amount was for. Yukon University was previously known as Yukon College and Innovation & Entrepreneurship was previously known as Cold Climate Innovation.

Timeframe: 01 April 2019 - 10 August 2021

Clarification:

I think the easiest way for me to clarify is to give an example.

The Public Accounts say "Incubation program development - \$85,000." I have no idea what "incubation program development" means. I am willing to wager that the Department does know precisely what it means because presumably the Department knew exactly the ways in which that particular funding amount would be spent.
