Any and all records, communications, and data of a white 2013 Peterbilt conventional tractor (Yukon Licence plate CJ937, and British Columbia licence plate LT 2304), driven by [NAME] for Hy's North Transport Ltd., that attended at the Yukon weigh scale stations between February 24, 2018 and February 27, 2018. The attached trailers had licence plates of 5KB9-24 (Alberta) and T 2304 (British Columbia). If there are any records, communications, and data that this semi-truck did not attend at any or all Yukon weigh scale stations between February 24, 2018 and February 27, 2018, please provide any and all records, communications or data regarding its non-attendance.
