Decision

We are asking for any records, of any kind that relate to the accident that happened on either [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. This would be all file notes, phone call notes, inter office or inter staff memos, reports, drafts of reports or any written record or written record of verbal exchanges that relate in any way to the accident described above, including but not limited to discussions regarding whether this was a work place accident or not. Written records or notes of conversations with the coroners office or RCMP.

All records found are listed in the attached records schedule and were withheld for the following reasons:

2	70(1)(3)(a)(iii)(vi)(A)(d)(i)(ii)	Information relates to a third parties employment, current or past physical health and to a law enforcement matter to which the third party is subject to. Disclosure of these records would be an unreasonable invasion of privacy.
