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**Decision**

The Department of Health and Social Services has searched Population and Public Health Evidence and Evaluation and has identified records responsive to Access Request 22-051. The final response on the information is as follows:

**Access Granted in Part**

The Department of Health and Social Services has granted access in part to the information relating to the request noted below:

**Number of positive COVID-19 cases recorded among both students and teachers in Yukon schools since November 18. I'm looking for all of the following:**

- 1. The number of students who have contracted COVID-19 since November 18, 2021;**
- 2. The number of teachers who have contracted COVID-19 since November 18, 2021;**
- 3. The number of each broken down by school.**

**Timeframe: November 18, 2021 to February 1, 2022**

Certain types of information have been redacted pursuant to the following sections of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act:

- 70(1) disclosure would be an unreasonable invasion of a third party's privacy
