Final Response ATIPP Access Request 22-105

Decision

The Department of Highways and Public Works has searched Property Management branch and has identified records responsive to Access Request #22-105. Our final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The Department of Highways and Public Works has provided records in part relating to the request noted below:

- a copy of contracts C00059323, C00059475 and any change orders - any contracts or change orders resulting from C00057079. Timeframe: October 1, 2020 - March 9, 2022

NARROWED SCOPE

Applicant response: Please narrow the request to the following: if any, the agreement, contract, or change order as a result of deficient work relating to C00057079. Timeframe: March 31, 2021 - present. Only include the monetary amount, contractor name, scope of work, and the substantial/total completion dates. Do not include email correspondence. Only looking for pages excerpted from the agreement/contract or change order.

Response from public body: The change order is 10 pages. There are no emails included in the original AIS. The vast majority of the other 9275 included pages are the scope of work for the \$67 million contract that change order is associated with but is not a result of the deficient work. Addition from ATIPP Office: Based on the narrowed scope, you would be looking at a revised page count of 10 if you are only looking for the change order.

Applicant response: That works.

Third party business information consisting of itemized prices that could reasonably be expected to result in undue financial loss or gain or harm the competitive position of the third party was redacted under section 77(1)(a)(c) of the ATIPP Act.
