Final Response ATIPP Access Request 22-163

Decision

The Department of Highways and Public Works searched the Offices of the Deputy Minister and Assistant Deputy Minister Transportation and the Transport Engineering Branch and identified records responsive to Access Request #22-163. Our final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The Department of Highways and Public Works has provided partial access to information and records relating to the request noted below:

All correspondence with the Deputy Minister, Assistant Deputy Minister, or Director of Transportation Engineering (emails, texts) relating to replacement of the Becker Creek and Wheaton River bridges. Timeframe: June 1, 2019 - April 1, 2022.

Third party personal information has been withheld under section 70(1)(3)(a)(iii) of the ATIPP Act. Disclosing this information would be an unreasonable invasion of a third party's privacy. Information withheld includes names, emails, phone numbers and employment history

Where legal advice was obtained legally privileged information has been withheld under section 73(a).

Some advice and recommendations made to the department or a Minister have been redacted as per section 74(1)(a).

Non-public contact information has been severed as per 75(1)(a)(ii) because its release would cause monetary harm.

Information internal to third party business operations that release has been identified as harmful to the interests of the business has been removed under section 77(1)(a).
