I am looking for the specific bid amounts per cord for the campground firewood contracts on an individual basis. The campground firewood delivery contract bid amounts for the 2022 season listed for each individual campground on a per cord basis. I am not looking for the complete total as provided through the bids and tender website. Timeframe: March 1, 2022 - April 28, 2022.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

I am not concerned about the specific company name. I am only wondering about the cost per individual cord delivered to each campground as listed in the tender document.

Information was withheld under section 72(1)(b)(vi) as disclosure would adversely affect the security of property or a system, including a building, vehicle, computer system or communications system.
