Decision

The Department of Environment has searched Assistant Deputy Ministers' Office, Conservation Officer Services branch, Deputy Minister's Office and Environmental Protection and Assessment branch and has identified records responsive to Access Request #22-278. The final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The Department of Environment is granting access in part to information relating to the request noted below:

Site Location: 2270 2nd Avenue, Whitehorse, YT Requesting records of any spills, discharges, citations, complaints, inspection reports, orders of non-compliance and any current Certificates of Approvals or amendments for the property. Timeframe: January 1, 2019 - June 1, 2022

Some of the records you requested contain information that has been withheld from disclosure under the ATIPP Act. We have severed the excepted information so that we could disclose to you the remaining information in the records. The records have been withheld pursuant to the following sections under the Access to Information and Protection Privacy Act (ATIPP Act):

ATIPP Act Sections

Explanation

- Section 70(1) Disclosure of the information would be an unreasonable invasion of the third party's privacy
- Section 72(1)(a)(iii) Disclosure may reveal the identity of a confidential source, or information that the source is providing or has provided, to a public body in respect of a law enforcement matter
- Section 72(1)(b)(iv) Disclosure may harm the reputation of a person or organization referred to in a report prepared for the purpose of a law enforcement matter
- Section 74(1)(a) Advice or recommendations prepared by or for a public body or a minister
